





Customer Relationship Management Systems (CRMs): Uses CRMs to collect and manage detailed information about individuals in the population, including their employment status and personal skills.

Jobs Portal: Developed and maintains an online jobs portal where vacancies in the Special Economic Zone are posted. This helps track available job opportunities and match them with job seekers.

Job Alerts: Implement a system for job alerts to notify registered users about new vacancies that match their skills and preferences.

Member Portal: Created a secure member portal for SEZ members to update their profiles, view job opportunities, and access resources.

Mailing Lists: Utilizes mailing lists to distribute information on job opportunities, training sessions, and other relevant updates to the community.



Based on the feedback received, CEC also develops workshops, training sessions and events, led by key experts, to help develop the talent pipeline.

Capture and process employer manpower requirements and information.	To capture and process employer manpower requirements and information, CEC tracks Zone Trade Certificate (ZTC) data, which includes SEZ company details regarding the number of initial employees and the number of employees expected to be added over time. The CEC's Client Experience team and Chief Executive Officer hold regular meetings with SEZ owners to explore how CEC can support their growth by helping to identify qualified local talent for current and future roles. Additionally, CEC provides monthly reports to SEZA, including statistics on population, workforce, unemployment, and available vacancies in the SEZs. Vacancies within the SEZs are promoted through various channels including the CEC Jobs Portal and widely promoted to CEC community members and Caymanians seeking employment within CEC's SEZs.
	 Enterprise Cayman Job Alerts and promoted via social media Cayman Compass Classified Advertising CEC Social Media Platforms Monthly Newsletters eCayTrade WORC, UCCI, ICCI Career Fairs Relevant Industry Associations CEC also collaborates regularly with recruitment agencies like CML Recruitment and NOVA, who assist with candidate placements and provide professional support.

- 1. The agreement between EC and the Government is 10 years old and should be reviewed and, if necessary, reformed to maintain relevance and to ensure that the essence of why they did this, is still being achieved. It would also be useful to consider how things can be improved.
- 2. I believe a review of the list of items under the commitment to Government should be conducted on an annual basis with the Minister for Financial Services to demonstrate achievements, identify any gaps and how they can be filled, and amend items which are no longer relevant.
- 3. This Annual Report and CEC's Economic Impact Assessment should be tabled in Cabinet, to raise awareness of achievements and to seek feedback. There remain some misconceptions about concessions and how much value CEC / SEZ adds to the economy, versus companies who could have registered the 'old fashioned way' and paid higher work permit fees, etc. A discussion with Cabinet should be useful in addressing this challenge.
- 4. It would be useful to host a forum with private sector stakeholders such as the Chamber of Commerce, the Law Association, the Bankers Association, Cayman Finance, etc, to discuss the EIA and the Annual Report, seek feedback, and find opportunities for closer collaboration / synergies.
- 5. Leverage EC's training and development methodology to tie into the jobs of the future to support the private sector beyond the EZ in developing the skills they require among the local workforce.
- 6. EC should conduct a 5-10 year skills gap analysis for its member companies to feed into manpower planning as an overall entity and to also inform the Government, WORC, and the Work Permit process about what's coming. Also, how can CEC itself help to find and / or train the talent to fill those gaps in the Cayman workforce?
- 7. Create a dashboard on EC's website that shows how many registered companies, which industries, how many employed, how many Caymanians employed, number of internship opportunities, number of events, Government revenue generated, etc so there is no need to await the EIA or annual report at the end of the year, but have a link to those as well, from the dashboard.
- 8. What are the sticking points to achieving all the requirements? Communicate those to the private and public sector as relevant, documented and in writing, and engage regularly in driving change even legislative changes to make things work better for all stakeholders.


